Required Courses Specifically Designed for Students in the LL.M. Program

U.S. Constitutional Law for Foreign Attorneys (2 cr.)

Introduces American constitutional law as traditionally studied in a first course in constitutional law. Covers the three branches of the federal government, how they interact, and how they relate to the states. Discusses American history and government to provide context.

U.S. Legal Research for Foreign Attorneys (2 cr.)

Introduces American law and philosophy. Explores methodology of American legal research, covers basic U.S. legal research of primary and secondary authorities utilizing print materials, online subscriptions, publicly available Internet sites, and other emerging research tools.
