

Karen Chadwick

Associate Professor

Professor Chadwick previously taught at the University of Detroit Mercy Law (UDM) from 1990-1999. At UDM she taught Torts, Products Liability, Advanced Torts, Legal Writing and Workers Compensation. At the time she left UDM, Professor Chadwick was a tenured Associate Professor of Law. Professor Chadwick also taught at Wayne State University Law School as an instructor of Legal Writing and Research and Advanced Writing from 1987-1990. In 1999, she taught Products Liability as an adjunct professor at WSU.

Professor Chadwick has written a number of articles in the Torts area. Her most recent article, *Is Leisure-Time Smoking a Valid Employment Consideration?*, 70 Alb. L. Rev. 117 (2006), addresses the potential conflict between an individual's right to privacy with respect to leisure-time activities and the right of an employer to refuse to hire employees who smoke cigarettes.

Professor Chadwick has also written on causation in products liability cases and negligent infliction of emotional distress. *"Causing" Enhanced Injuries in Crashworthiness Cases*, 48 Syracuse L. Rev. 1223 (1998); *Fear of Aids: The Catalyst for Expanding Judicial Recognition of a Duty to Prevent Emotional Distress Beyond Traditional Bounds*, 25 N.M.L. Rev. 143 (1995).

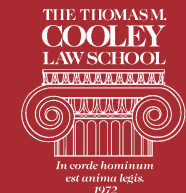

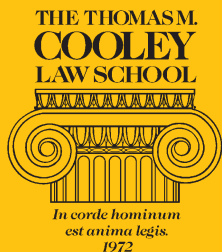
