## Professor

Professor Dotson publishes on product liability and general tort and remedies topics, including prescription drug liability for drug manufacturers and the enforceability of liquidated damages clauses in employment contracts. He also is a consultant/editor for two major periodicals by West Publications: *Stein's on Personal Injury Damages and Emotional Injuries: Law and Practice* (2009). These periodicals are widely used by personal injury litigators and expert witnesses as a resource when they confront substantive liability and remedy issues as well as when they seek practice tips.

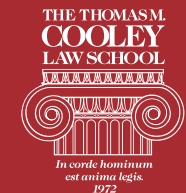

COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE.

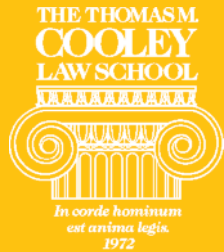
