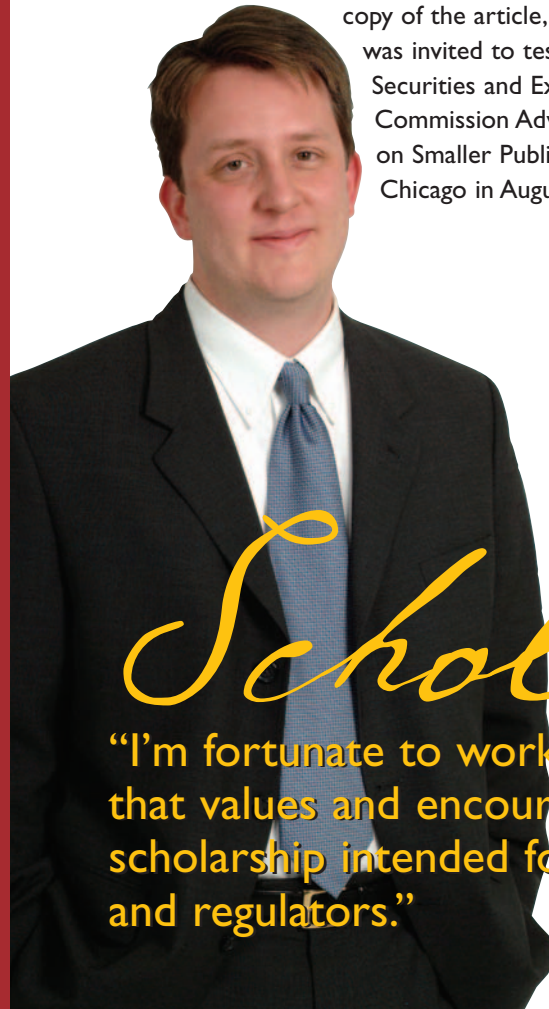


# Michael Molitor

Professor Molitor was an attorney with the Grand Rapids, Mich., law firm of Warner Norcross & Judd LLP from 1994 to 2004.
